

**BY-LAW NO. 588-20**

**A BY-LAW OF THE VILLAGE OF WARNER, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO REPEAL CERTAIN OBSOLETE AND SUPERCEDED BY-LAWS, OR AMEND CERTAIN OTHER BYLAWS.**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 191 of the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A. 2000, as amended, a council may amend or repeal a by-law, and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 63(2)(b) of the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A. 2000, as amended, a by-law may authorize the omitting and provide for the repeal of a by-law or a provision of a by-law that is inoperative, obsolete, expired, spent or otherwise ineffective, and

**WHEREAS**, Council deems it appropriate to repeal certain obsolete By-Laws of the Village of Warner,


**NOW THEREFORE**, the Council of the Village of Warner, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

1. **THAT** following By-Laws hereby be repealed due to obsolescence and superseded:
